School	All	ROAD SAFETY: The entrance to the school is clearly marked with a yellow grid indicating no parking, along with double yellow lines running alongside the pavement by the scooter parking bay and in front of The Leaf restaurant. In the interests of safety, from September all parents/carers will need to use the overflow carpark at the end of the day to collect your child/children from school. Please do not park on the double yellow lines or stop along the road as this creates a traffic jam.
