Alan Turing 1912-54

Alan Turing



- WWII worked at Bletchley Park
- Turing developed a machine (the Bombe) which broke the Nazi's Enigma codes (a device sending coded messages to German armed forces) - saving thousands of lives across Europe and shorting the war by two years!



 His work was top secret for many years - very few people were aware of the importance of what he had done

Alan Turing



- Turing was gay which was illegal during his lifetime.
- 1952 Turing arrested for gross indecency.



- Security risk all of his highly secret work for GCHQ and other government organisations were stopped.
- September 2009, the Prime Minister, Gordon Brown, issued a public apology on behalf of the government, for the way that Alan Turing had been treated.
- 2017 Under the amendment dubbed "Turing law" deceased people who were convicted for offences that once criminalised homosexuality receive an automatic pardon


- Father of modern computing



We expect all pupils to follow our three St. Katherine's Ready to Learn expectations:

- Be responsible by arriving on time and fully equipped
- Be respectful by listening and speaking politely
- Be resilient by remaining on task and working hard

What happens if a pupil is not 'Ready to Learn'?



- For example: arriving late to the lesson or talking out of turn
 - a teacher will tell them that they have a "warning" and their name will be recorded
 - If a pupil does this for a second time, they will be sent to the Ready to Learn room for a full day i.e. 5 periods (After phased introduction in Term 1 for Y7)


Top Tips on how best to support your child
