## **Collecting Certificates**

If you intend to collect your certificates on Wednesday 8th January, could you confirm in advance giving your name by email to examcertificates@skdrive.org.

If you are not able to collect your certificates on that day you can either:

Send a cheque made payable to Cathedral Schools Trust for £5 with a signed letter confirming the address where you would like the certificates to be posted.

Or

Nominate someone to collect the certificates for you. You will need to complete • the form we have provided overleaf which the nominated person should bring along with identification when they collect your certificates. If they do not bring this nomination form and ID we will not be able to release your certificates.

It is important that you collect your certificates and keep them safe as you will need them for your future education and employment. Please note we are obliged to retain your certificates at the centre for one year only. If you do not collect these documents your only option in the future would be to contact the exam boards directly and request a Certified Statement of Results which can be in the region of £45 per board.
