7. Music Department– Abi

i) Years 7,8 and 9 have to have music lessons in normal classrooms; Year 10 and 11 can use the music rooms but there is no singing, brass or woodwind playing. Happily, instrumental lessons are continuing either face to face or online in the case of singing, brass and woodwind.

Year 7 and 8 have a carousel of enrichment activities on alternate Tuesday afternoons which are working well. These include ukulele sessions (with the ukeleles SKAMPS helped to purchase) which are very successful.
