The total score is then converted into a grade. Combined<br>science is worth two GCSE grades, so students will get 2 grades. This <u>video</u><br>was produced by the government when the combined science qualification<br>first started. The video explains how the grading system works in combined<br>science compared to single (triple) science.   |  |
