Whole School	Reception	Lost property: We have a multitude of clothing in our lost property drawers, please remind your child to have a look through if needed.
Υ7	Mrs Ball	 We are delighted to be able to offer our students Bikeability Level 3, advanced on-road cycle training, free of charge. The course is funded by North Somerset Council and the Department for Transport and delivered by Life Cycle UK. Week beginning Monday 27th March during the school day, students will complete a one-off 3-hour session. Allocation of time and dates will follow. To access Level 3 training, every student must have already completed their Level 2 training, usually in primary school, and will need a helmet to take part. Bikes can be borrowed and used from the Bikeability team for the session. Places on this valuable training are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. After an initial assessment of their riding skills, they will be riding on busy and challenging roads, with qualified instructors. Please ensure that your child has suitable clothing, especially if the weather is wet/change of clothes/ gloves for cold weather coats. Please return the consent form by Monday 20th February, hard copies are also available in reception.
School	All years	North Somerset Council have advised us that there will be a temporary road closure and vertical traffic calming during half term. A new 20mph limit will be in force from Monday 20 February.

Miss Cave	All years	Free School Meals - if you think you are entitled to claim a free school meal benefit because of your income or circumstances it's essential you apply. For each eligible child, the school receives funding for the next six years, even if their parents go back to full-time paid work. You can apply to North Somerset <u>here</u> . If you have any queries or would like the school to support you with your application please contact reception.
