This year sees the 60th anniversary of the Bristol Bus Boycott that Paul led and paved the way for the Race Relations Act. | Miss Cave | Whole school | Free School Meals If you think you are entitled to claim a free school meal benefit because of your income or circumstances it's essential you apply. For each eligible child, the school receives funding for the next six years, even if their parents go back to full-time paid work. You can apply to North Somerset here . | Miss Cave | Whole school | Free School Meals If your child is entitled to a free school meal they can receive breakfast in the canteen before 8.30. They will be able to choose from the following; • 2 pieces of toast with jam • fresh fruit with a juice drink • porridge with honey/syrup with a juice drink • cereal with milk • 1 crumpet with jam. |
| Finance | Whole school | Lunch accounts From term 6 the school will be moving from Aspens to a new external catering company, Innovate Services Ltd. In order to assist us with this transfer, all lunch accounts will need to be in credit on 26th May 23. Recently a number of lunch accounts have gone overdrawn. These accounts will need to be topped up to clear the debts. Parentpay allows you to set a reminder to top up when the balance falls below a certain amount. To set an alert go to 'Communication', 'Alert Settings', 'Balance Alerts'. Set a threshold amount (say £5) and tick the email box. You will then be emailed a low balance alert when your child's lunch account falls below £5. Lunch accounts should always remain in credit |
