During Term 6 the school suffered a catastrophic electrical failure following the storm during the weekend of 10 June which cut off Pill village. As a result, the school has been undertaking significant investigative work to fix the resulting faults which are extensive. Despite being fully tested during the break, a new failure has occurred affecting the canteen. As a precaution, we ask that families provide snacks and a packed lunch this week as the canteen will be operating a limited service.

RAAC

You will have seen in the media the recent issues around Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC) in school buildings. We appreciate the concern this may raise, and please be reassured that we will always prioritise the safety of your children and our staff. We do not have any confirmed RAAC in our buildings and have not been asked to close any areas. However, we want to take care and to be sure, and are currently working with the DfE to actively check whether RAAC has been used in the construction of any part of our buildings that we have not already assessed. If RAAC is identified, we will let you know straight away, and put any necessary contingencies in place.
