Finance	School Bus	School Bus Direct Debit The first direct debit for this academic year will be taken either Tue 12th or Wed 13th September. The file to be sent to BACS is currently being checked thoroughly for all starters and leavers to ensure the information is accurate. Direct debits for October onwards will be on the 1st of the month.
School	School Bus	All bus users have now been issued with their credit card sized bus pass. This should be shown every day when boarding the bus. Should a student lose their bus pass then a new one can be ordered via main reception and a charge of £2 will be added to ParentPay. Students are reminded that they should remain seated and wear a seat belt at all times. Sirona	Whole school	This autumn all children from Y7 to Year 11 are being offered a flu vaccine as part of the School Vaccination Programme. The flu vaccine is administered using a nasal spray. Sirona Immunisation team will be on site on the 5 December to administer this vaccine . Please complete the <u>consent form</u> , indicating whether you wish your child to have the vaccine, ensure you complete the consent form even if you do not want your child to receive the vaccinationIf your child is not able to attend school on the day of the Immunisation session they can attend a catch-up clinic at a later date.
