School	Bus Users	 Code of Conduct All bus users are reminded of the conduct that is expected from all users. The full document can be seen on the final page of our travel guide but the three most important rules are reproduced here: Carry a valid bus pass and show it on request. Like most forms of public transport we require all passengers to carry evidence of their right to travel. Passes will not be requested on every journey but rather checked periodically. If a bus pass is lost then a new one can be requested at the school reception. Sit in the allocated area of the bus. Students are allocated seat number with year 11 at the back of the bus and year 7 at the front. Wear a seat belt at all times. This is not only a legal responsibility of each passenger but also necessary for the safety of all users.
School	Whole School	Lost Property Please ensure your children's uniforms are clearly labelled so that if lost, they make it to lost property, we can get it returned to them. Lost property is held in reception and PE. There are still plenty of lockers available to rent so students can keep track of their belongings.
School	Whole school	Free School Meals If you think you are entitled to claim a free school meal benefit because of your income or circumstances it's essential you apply. For each eligible child, the school receives funding for the next six years, even if their parents go back to full-time paid work. You can apply to North Somerset here. If you have any queries or would like the school to support you with your application please contact reception.
School	Whole school	Free School Meals If your child is entitled to a free school meal they can receive breakfast in the canteen before 8.30. They will be able to choose from the following; • 2 pieces of toast with jam • fresh fruit with a juice drink • porridge with honey/syrup with a juice drink • cereal with milk • 1 crumpet with jam.
