Sirona	Year 9	All Y9 children will be offered the Meningococcal ACWY vaccination and Diphtheria, Tetanus and Polio vaccination in school on Tuesday 23 April 2024. Please complete the consent form. It is important that you complete the consent form even if you do not want your child to receive the vaccinations; you are able to consent for none, either or both vaccinations. If your child has received the Men ACWY vaccine as a travel vaccine since the age of 10 they do not need an additional booster at this time. Please indicate whether they have received MenACWY as a travel vaccine on the consent form and contact your GP surgery who will be able to confirm the date it was given. Mr Francis Black	Year 9	There have been a number of questions about year 9 options for Science which I would like to clarify. Students must select between Triple (3 separate GCSEs in Biology, Chemistry and Physics) or Combined Science (2 GCSEs where the sciences are mixed together). Triple Science will take one option block leaving 3 other choices whereas Combined Science does not count as an option and students would still have 4 blocks to fill. Both Triple and Combined Science are available at foundation and higher tiers. In previous years two thirds of students have opted for Triple Science giving us four classes with three higher and one foundation. That leaves 3 classes for combined science that based on the students in them have all been foundation. The number of triple and combined classes next year will be determined by the options that students make and whilst the teaching will be aimed and the appropriate tier for the students in each class, the individual tier of entry for each student will not be fixed until after year 11 mock exam data is collected. Science teachers make a recommendation to students about which option they should select based on strong evidence about where each student is likely to achieve the highest grades.
