

St Katherine's School Remote Learning Statement

During periods of partial or full school closure, St Katherine's School is committed to providing continuous learning opportunities for all students. Work and learning materials will be delivered via Google Classrooms, our established online platform, ensuring students can access lessons, assignments, and resources in a structured and familiar environment.

In the event of an unexpected school closure, remote learning provision will commence no later than the second day of closure. On the first day, students are encouraged to engage with the school's existing web-based learning resources, such as Sparx Maths and Sparx Science, to maintain engagement and reinforce key skills while staff prepare and upload tailored learning activities to Google Classrooms. This ensures students have immediate access to meaningful educational content immediately.

In the event of longer-term closures, St Katherine's School will maintain regular communication with students and families to provide updates, support, and guidance. Pastoral care will always remain a priority, and pastoral staff will contact students to monitor their well-being and engagement. This ongoing contact helps to identify and address any challenges students may face during extended periods away from school, ensuring that both their academic progress and personal development continue to be supported.

We will communicate clearly with students and parents about how to access Google Classrooms and the web-based learning platforms, providing guidance to support effective use. Our remote education strategy is designed to maintain high standards of quality and accessibility, ensuring all students continue to make progress during any disruption to onsite learning.
