## PARIS 2020 6 - 10 JULY 2020

The Paris trip for Year 7 students has always been a great success and St Katherines is very proud to be able to take students on a week of cultural discovery and wonder. It is a great enrichment opportunity that our students always enjoy. Next July, our itinerary will include visits to the most famous landmarks in Paris: the Eiffel Tower, the Sacre Coeur and Montmartre and the Stade de France. Students will enjoy dinner in a typical French creperie. To finish, their efforts in using French in various activities over the week will be rewarded by a day in Disneyland Paris Theme Park.

The cost of the trip is £553. This includes travel, entry to all venues and food. In order to secure a place on the trip, please pay £140 non-refundable deposit via ParentPay; complete and return the Essential Information form and sign and return the Terms and Conditions, by **Friday 29 November.** 

Please note that places on this trip are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. The trip will be available on Parentpay from mid-day on Monday 18 November.

We have broken down the rest of the payments over the year (please see the Terms and Conditions attached). However, should you wish to pay in one payment this can be arranged.

The viability of the trip does depend on all students who have booked a place participating. If, due to exceptional circumstances, you feel you must withdraw your son/daughter you must contact me urgently to discuss the circumstances. Please be aware that should you withdraw your child after Wednesday 1 April 2020, the full amount of the cost of the trip is non-refundable and you remain liable for any outstanding payments. Students will only be able to participate if full payment has been received. Please be aware that any student whose behaviour is deemed unacceptable during the year will not be allowed to participate in this trip.

# PARIS 2020 - TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## **Payment**

A deposit of £140 must be received by Friday 29 November 2019. This is non-refundable and in conjunction with the return of the completed Essential Information Form and a signed copy of this document, is the point at which your child's place is confirmed. Parentpay will be available from Monday 18 November at noon. You will be required to use ParentPay to pay the remaining balance and to help spread the cost of the trip, a schedule is set

If the interim payments are not met, this does not constitute a request to withdraw your child's place from the trip. You must notify the school in writing at the earliest opportunity if you have any problems making these payments.

# Medical and Emergency Contact Information

Your child will not be allowed to participate in any out of school activity without the signed Essential Information Form which accompanies the trip letter. It is your responsibility to inform us of any changes to the information on this form prior to the departure date.

## Insurance

All trips are fully insured by the school journey insurance. If your cancellation falls within the terms of the policy, the insurance may cover these charges.

If your child is unable to take up their place due to a medical condition, we will need confirmation in writing from your GP. Please contact us before you obtain this information.

Electronic items such as cameras, iPods, mobile phones and games consoles are not covered by the school insurance. These are taken at the owner's risk.

## Passport and EHIC cards

Students will be traveling under their own passport and therefore require an in date passport for this trip. All students are required to have EHIC card (European Health Insurance Card). You can apply for this online – visit the Department of Health website for details; by phone - call 0845 606 20 30 or by post - pick up the EHIC form at a Post Office.

The school reserves the right to remove from any trip/activity a student whose behaviour has given cause for concern at any stage during the year.

If a student does not meet our expectations during the trip, arrangements will be made for him / her to return before the rest of the group. The parent/carer will be responsible for any expenses incurred. The cost for any property damaged due to the carelessness /misconduct of a student will be the responsibility of the parent/carer.
