As you may have been aware Bristol Cathedral Choir School has hosted a Community Iftar for the last three years. This Iftar has been open to all BCCS students of all faiths and none, including their immediate families, and is always free of charge. With the event bringing joy to many and it's growing success year-on-year, we feel determined to host the event this year. We extend a particular welcome this year to families from Trinity Academy and St Katherine's.

This year, Cathedral Schools Trust (CST) in partnership with the Ifar Project welcome you to share the Iftar experience online. The event will be held on Thursday 14th May via Google Meet beginning at 8pm, and end just after sunset (8.57/8.58pm). Ismaeel Akram, a former student and Project Manager of the Community Iftar Project will be joined by guest speakers, discussing the topic of Ramadan in lockdown. During the event we shall receive your emails and texts so together we can share our thoughts, photos and questions. The event will be closed with a live call to prayer.

We would also like you to send questions for our speakers to us in advance when you express your interest, and they will do their best to answer as many of these as possible during the evening.

We offer you free specially prepared food for your family's lftar meal. The meals are being prepared by Ahmed's Masala Cafe restaurant and should be collected by yourselves from the BMCS premises (based in Easton) The Pickle Factory, 13 All Hallows Road, Bristol, BS5 0HH. The meals are vegetarian and not gluten free nor dairy free.
