Buyback:

To mitigate the cost of skirts and trousers, and in response to previous requests from the PCA, we will look to facilitiate a second-hand uniform service and purchase any uniform in good, reusable condition at 50% of the original cost.

*the cost of trousers/skirt from the current supplier is the average of three costs taken from a range of shops.

^the indicated cost of the Monkhouse skirt refers to skirt A.

Proposed roll out



Current Yr7 and Yr8 pupils will be supplied with either a skirt or pair of trousers.

Current Yr9 and Yr10 pupils will not be affected by the uniform change.

All students in receipt of the Pupil Premium will receive a discount of 10% on uniform if purchased through the school as well as a £40 voucher for uniform.
