HEADTEACHER'S UPDATE

Dear Parents/Carers

The letters circulated this week regarding positive test results serve as a reminder to us all that the virus is still within our communities. Thank you to you all for being vigilant and where you have suspected symptoms acting swiftly to get tested and not allow your child/ren to come to school. With each of us playing our part, we very much hope we can continue to be open for all year groups throughout the summer months ahead. Thank you to the Year 11 parents/carers for their patience and understanding at the beginning of the week.

A reminder re: Test and Trace support payment for parents

Parents and carers of children who have been advised to self-isolate by their education setting or by NHS Test and Trace are now able to apply for a <u>Test and Trace Support Payment</u> or discretionary payment of £500, if they meet the eligibility criteria. This change is intended to ensure that eligible parents receive financial support if they are unable to attend work due to childcare responsibilities. We continue to promote our value of excellence and have recently established a new gallery in school. The work students have produced during the past twelve months is of the highest quality reflecting some incredible artistic flair. Testing at home throughout the Easter holidays for schools and colleges

Following the success of the asymptomatic testing programme on the return to school and college, it is vital to keep testing at home throughout the Easter holidays and into the summer term. Please pass on this message to all of your staff, students and parents:

- test twice a week at home from now on (all those who are able to)
- report results <u>online</u> as positive, negative or void. This information is critical in helping us to understand the prevalence of the virus across the country
- continue to test twice weekly over the Easter holidays
- test before returning to school or college for the summer term, either the night before, or morning of, the first day back, to find and isolate any positive cases

Families and households can also access <u>home test kits for adults</u>.





Year 11 and Year 13

Our plans for the awarding of grades for Year 11 and Year 13 have been shared with students. In this week's video, Mr Francis-Black, Assistant Headteacher on assessment and reporting explains some examples of subject assessment from the portal introduced last week which illustrates how each subject will be assessed.
