HEADTEACHER'S UPDATE

Dear Parents/Carers

Last weekend was a great signal and reminder to us that routines are beginning to return with over fifty students taking part in a series of Duke of Edinburgh expedition workshops with staff. This reflects great engagement from our Year 9s in our co-curriculum and we encourage all young people to take part in an award which develops broader skills and characteristics. The accreditation of the Award is universally acknowledged as a mark of personal leadership, teamwork and community contribution in an entirely non-competitive environment. No doubt we have all recently reflected on the significant impact HRH Prince Philip had on education through the Duke of Edinburgh Award at St Katherine's. We have this week confirmed the changes to our curriculum for September following the consultation with stakeholders and we are looking forward to a fresh beginning in many ways in September. Year 11 and Year 13 have continued their assessments this week with many completing their final assessment. Staff have been stepping their way through our thorough and rigorous process of moderation and validation on Monday and this work continues until after half term. It was a busy return to school on Tuesday with the student protest which I reflected on in my letter to parents/carers this week. We will continue the work we have started this term and will share this with our community next term. After the disruption and challenge of Tuesday, it was pleasing to listen to the feedback from colleagues across the trust who spent the day with us on Wednesday as part of our CST School Improvement Day. The feedback was very positive and students spoke highly of the school and their experience, commenting on the improvements they see in the school. The improvements the school has made were very evident on the day and we look forward to continuing to improve St Katherine's. Our School Development Plan for 2021-23 is currently being drafted and will be shared during Term 6 with all stakeholders.
