Two positive LFDs in Year 10

Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for continuing to be vigilant within our community around COVID 19. We have had two positive LFD results reported today in Year 10. We are awaiting the results of the confirmatory PCR test.

As a result

- All Year 10 students will be Learning@Home tomorrow - Monday 14 June. Close contacts required to self isolate will be contacted separately by letter. Any positive result from a Lateral Flow Device (LFD) carried out at home is followed by a PCR test.
- Any student in any year group who travelled on the SK2 (St Katherine's SK2 bus) on Friday 11 June must now self isolate.

We will write to all parents/carers tomorrow to confirm the outcome from the PCR tests and confirm a return to school as soon as possible.

Learning@Home

Lessons for tomorrow will be a combination of live lessons and independent lessons all delivered through Google Classroom. We will endeavour to do all we can to help students keep engaged in their learning during this time, particularly for Year 12 and Year 10 with mock examinations. We will review the mock examinations in light of this disruption.

Thank you for your continued understanding and support. Please continue to be disciplined and vigilant around symptoms within your household. We recognise this continues to be an unsettling time for year groups concerned and will work to reassure students of the steps we are taking to keep us all safe at St Katherine's.
