Dear Parents/Carers

We continue with the theme of COVID 19 which remains present within our community. We continue to monitor the cases across our community and thank you to everyone for testing and reporting regularly. Please read the <u>attached letter</u> which the Department for Education has promoted to all schools. It is critical that each of us plays our part. We are aware of some frustrations staff and families are experiencing regarding multiple positive LFDs followed by negative PCR tests and this appears to be prevalent in the South West. Please continue to follow the guidelines and test twice weekly.

Thank you for your continued patience and tolerance with resolving uniform at the start of this year. We recognise this is still not resolved for all families and please be reassured we will continue to make adjustments and will support all families until the supply issues are resolved. Once resolved, we will confirm the steps we are taking with families to ensure the experiences of this year are not repeated.

Next Thursday is our first Online Parent/Carer Association Meeting of the year. For new families who have joined us this year, all parents/carers are welcome. Miss	Richards	Allν	/ears
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This autumn, all young people aged 12-15 are being offered a first dose of the Covid-19 vaccine at the same time as the annual flu vaccine.

Children who are 12 years old and over on the day the School Age Immunisation Service (SAIS) team visits, will be offered a Covid-19 vaccination as part of the in-school vaccination programme. For those under the age of 12, they will be offered a flu vaccination. The SAIS team will visit on Monday 18th, Tuesday 19th and Wednesday 20th October. Students will only be vaccinated if consent has been obtained from parents.

Our local SAIS provider, Sirona Care & Health, is legally responsible for the delivery of the Covid-19 vaccine and flu vaccine. Parents/Carers can provide consent for both the flu and the Covid-19 vaccine, for one or other of the vaccines or neither. St Katherine's is not delivering or responsible for the vaccines and so will not have access to any of the consent data that is gathered. However, we will share the consent links with you early next week.

Miss Richards	Year 11	We have now received confirmation of the structure of the 2022 Summer examinations. The summary of changes is as follows: There will be optional topics and content in GCSE English literature, history and geography. Art and photography will be assessed via the portfolio only. Exam boards will provide advanced information about the focus of the content of exams for all GCSE subjects except GCSE English literature, history and geography by 7 February 2022 at the latest. Students will be given a formulae sheet for GCSE mathematics and a revised equation sheet for GCSE physics and combined science. Usually, previous years are used to outline grade boundaries. However, this year, grades will be designed to reflect an average between 2021 and 2019. This means that results next year will be higher than in 2019 but not as high as in 2021. With these changes in mind, we will provide students with content lists to support with their mock preparation. Their first set of mocks will begin at the end of November.
