Dear Parents/Carers

Year 9 Progress Evening – Thursday 4 November 2021

I write to invite you to this important evening in our school calendar, where you will have the opportunity to discuss your child's progress with their teachers.

We ask you to make appointments using our online <u>Parents' Evening booking system</u> and attach a <u>guidance</u> <u>sheet</u> for booking appointments through the system. Subject teachers will be available for consultation from 4.00pm to 7.00pm by appointment. The system opens for booking at 16:00 pm on Thursday 21 October and closes at 16:00 pm on Wednesday 3 November.

Our online booking system, in addition to being the means by which appointments are made, has a video call feature which we will use for the meetings with teachers. In order to attend the Virtual Progress Evening you will need to have as a minimum:

- A device with a microphone and speaker
- A compatible web browser:
 - iPhone/iPad Safari
 - Android Chrome or Firefox
 - Windows Chrome, Firefox or Microsoft Edge
 - Mac Safari, Chrome or Firefox
 - Linux Chrome or Firefox
- A reliable internet connection with upload speed of at least 3 Mbps
- It is advised that you test each of the components ahead of the meetings

Full details on how to attend your appointments, including a helpful video, can be found <u>here</u>. One thing to be aware of is that it is **essential to be on time** for all appointments. Each appointment will start at the booked time with a countdown clock at the top of the screen and if you are late or leave and rejoin the call, it does not reset the timer. The appointment will automatically end at the scheduled time and teachers do not have the ability to override the timer.

If you are unable to use the online booking facility, please call 01275 373737 and we will make the bookings with you over the phone. Alternatively, you can email slots when you will be available to <u>school@skdrive.org</u> and we will confirm bookings with you by return.

My child's progress check is to hand so that we can discuss specific aspects with teachers	
My child is available to join the appointments and discuss their learning
