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Mrs Crocker	All years	<b>Internet Safety</b> It is really important to chat with your children on an ongoing basis about staying safe online. Not sure where to begin? The UK Safer Internet Centre has advice for parents including conversation starters that can help open up communication with children. The UK Safer Internet has a huge range of support and guidance for parents too. You can find the conversation starters <u>here</u> .
Miss Richards	All years	Please support your child in completing their lateral flow tests at home. Twice weekly testing should continue during the half term break and students should also test on Tuesday 2 November, the day before we return to school. Results should be recorded on classcharts and on the government test and trace website.
Finance	All years	Recently a number of lunch accounts have gone overdrawn. To avoid this, Parentpay allows you to set a reminder to top up when the balance falls below a certain amount.



		To set an alert go to 'Communication', 'Alert Settings', 'Balance Alerts'. Set a threshold amount (say £5) and tick email box. You will then be emailed a low balance alert when your child's lunch account falls below £5. You can also set alerts for new items added to child's Parentpay account.
