School	All years	New school gates The new school gates provide an additional safety measure for our school community and will be fully operational from Monday 6 December. The gates are scheduled to be closed during the school day and visitors will need to push the call bell on the gate for reception. Our reception team will release the gate for access and visitors are asked to then proceed to reception as normal. We ask that you do not arrange to meet your child at the gates to pass on forgotten items such as lunch, PE kit etc. and to follow the usual procedure of reporting to reception in person. We will always pass on items or messages that come in during the day. We thank you for your support with this.	
Miss Richards	All years	Covid 19 Testing We have been informed by the Department for Education that we are expected to implement on site Covid-19 testing once again for January 2022. Each student will be asked to complete one test upon their return. Testing will be carried out by students and supervised by a trained adult. Students will be asked to come out of lessons during the first three days of term to complete the test. We will assume that the latest consent we hold on record for your child remains the same unless parents contact the school to inform otherwise. If your child has tested positive for Covid-19 since Wednesday 7 October, they will not be expected to complete the lateral flow test when they return to school. To ensure students are not asked to complete their lateral flow test where this is the case, please inform us via this form if your child has tested positive for Covid-19 since Wednesday 7 October.
