We continue to work closely with Turners who are facing increased costs and competition with wage and fuel cost inflation. We have worked hard together to minimise any increased costs and an additional £5 per month is necessary to keep the service running smoothly. The cost for the full year in 2022/23 will be £900 payable in ten monthly instalments of £90 from September to June. All current bus users should have received a personal email asking you to confirm your requirements for next year via an online form.
