The sharing festival will take place on **Monday 25 March**. We will open doors at **4.30pm** to welcome families to prepare for a prompt start at **5pm** in the **Cresswell Theatre at Bristol Cathedral Choir School**. We would then like to invite everyone to **share an iftar meal at around 6.30pm**. This year's theme is going to be **the power of community**. Thanks to the efforts of our student leaders and the student community, we will be celebrating some fantastic work and hearing from some wonderful speakers from the local community.

Just as we did last year, there will be a live call to prayer. Dates and water will be provided by the [Community Iftar Project](#) for everyone to break their fast on. After a group prayer, everyone will be invited down to our café area to enjoy a delicious shared meal prepared and cooked by members of our refugee community.

We would like to invite all BCCS/St Katherine's School students of all faiths and none, including their immediate family, to join us in sharing the celebration of this very special occasion. Ramadan, just like every religious festival, is about bringing family and friends together. We would like to come together as a school community at the beginning of Ramadan as one big family and share something special together.

We will be providing food for the shared iftar meal. You will have the opportunity to provide donations which will be going towards local charities.

We are inviting not only members of staff to take part in a sponsored fast if they wish, but also any students who would like to try and fast on the day. They are welcome to share their experience with friends and family. Our students will be choosing a charity and sending out a link next week - all money raised will go towards supporting the chosen charity.
