This is achieved through a structured programme that includes dedicated careers lessons and workshops, employer encounters, careers fairs, guest speaker sessions, and regular use of the Unifrog platform.

Milestones and Learning Outcomes

Year 11

Post-16 Options

To support students in making informed decisions about their further education pathways.

Outcomes: Students will be supported in achieving their post-16 goals through a range of targeted activities. These include one-to-one careers interviews, participation in the Year 11 Futures Day, attendance at provider events, and awareness-raising assemblies. Together, these opportunities will equip students with the information they need to make confident and informed decisions about their post-16 pathways.

Year 10

Work Experience and Post-16 Preparation

Aim: To complete a week of work experience and begin preparing for life beyond Year 11.

Outcomes: Students will take part in a one-week work experience placement during the summer term, helping them to develop transferable skills that will support future applications for education, training, or employment. Through this experience, students will gain valuable insights into various employers and career paths. They will also deepen their understanding of post-16 options, including sixth form, college, and further/higher education, with the aim of raising career aspirations.

Year 9

What Are My Options?

Aim: To help students understand how different subjects connect to careers and post-16 qualifications, supporting informed choices for Key Stage 4.

Outcomes: Students will gain insight into how their GCSE option subjects, personal skills, and hobbies can link to future careers. This understanding will be demonstrated through skills tracking and reflection activities on the Unifrog platform.

Year 8

Learning About the Real World

Aim: To deepen students' understanding of a variety of careers and how to set and work towards personal goals.



Year 7
